## AAeV Show Rules Fleece Show 2025 / WAC Germany Ilshofen

- 1. Only fleeces from the 2024 (Suri 2023-2024) shearing may participate.
- 2. The animals must be at least 6 months old at the time of shearing; fleeces from younger animals will not be assessed.
- 3. The fibre must have a minimum length of 5 cm and have grown for at least 183 days.
- 4. Fleeces that are matted or infested with parasites will not be assessed.
- 5. The organiser accepts no liability for the return, loss or condition of the fleeces.
- 6. The fleeces are sorted by gender, age and colour.
- 7. Age groups in months: 6 > 14 / 14 > 24 / 24 > 36 / 36 > 48 / 48 > 60 / older 60
- 8. It is judged in the colour classes white / beige, light fawn / fawn / brown / black / grey / appaloosa\*1 / multicolor\*2 and roan.
- 9. If fewer than 2 fleeces compete in a ring, the judge decides whether and how the fleeces are placed. First place does not have to be awarded.
- 10. Huacaya and Suri are evaluated separately.
- 11. In the event of a tie, the judge decides.
- 12. Colour Champion / Reserve Colour Champion Huacaya and Suri are determined from the first and second placed fleeces separately according to colour, sex and breed. This is strictly based on points. There must be 6 fleeces in one colour class.
- 13. The Grand Champion and Reserve Champion mares and stallions at Suri and Huacaya are determined from the Colour Champion. The best fleeces are re-evaluated by both judges and together they decide on the placement. In the Suri competition, 15 fleeces must have competed in one gender.
- 14. Best of Huacaya / Best of Suri: The BEST OF Show is determined from the Grand Champion mares and stallions. Here too, both judges jointly decide on the title. For the suris, 30 fleeces must have competed.
- \*1 Appaloosa must have at least 6 spots in the blanket (which is not grey).

\*2 Multicolour have at least one spot larger than 20 cm in diameter or at least 2 (or more) spots larger than 5 cm.
